



**Professor Katerina Maridaki-Kassotaki**

Katerina was born in Crete in 1956. She studied Psychology at the University of Crete and received her Ph.D. degree at the University of Lancaster. In 1997 she was elected Associate Professor of Psychology at Harokopio University where she has been teaching till today in the rank of Professor, in which she was promoted in 2008. She has been serving as Vice-Rector of Academic Affairs and Personnel at Harokopio University since 2003. She is the Director of the Graduate Program “Education and Culture” and responsible for the Counseling Centre for students of the above university. She was the Greek National Manager of the PISA Program of the OECD for four years. She is member of the British Psychological Association, and was General Secretary of the Greek Psychological Association. Her research interests focus on the development of memory and mind during childhood as well as on emotional intelligence and family relations. She is the author of six books and many papers in English and Greek.
